In total, mangrove forests provide at least US \$16 billion each year in ecosystem services 3 Mangrove resources are used directly by processing mangrove wood to charcoal and other forestry products, while a large share of global fishery depends directly or through food chains on mangroves - some scientific estimates amount up to 80% 4
